Tips for Protecting Your Information

1. Protect your passwords.
 - a. Use secure, lengthy passwords with special characters
 - b. Two factor authentication
 - c. Get a master security software, RoboForm is example
2. Update your devices frequently.
 - a. An old version may not have most secure measures
 - b. You can set smart devices to auto update
 - c. Web browsers, apps on your phone should be updated
3. Check all sender email address.
 - a. Often the fake emails have just one or two letters changed
4. Manage your social media privacy settings.
 - a. These places are where thieves find answers to security questions
5. Use a full-service internet security software.
 - a. Make sure it is on autorun to constantly check for issues
6. Watch your Money!
 - a. Pay attention to your money flows at least once per week
 - b. Mint.com or personal capital can help you monitor everything in one place
7. Be wary to callers who say your device has been compromised.
 - a. In reality, nobody will call you to say this. Hang up when you hear this!

Bonus: Is there one person that knows where all your accounts are? Do they have all logins?
This is important should you become disabled or pass away.
